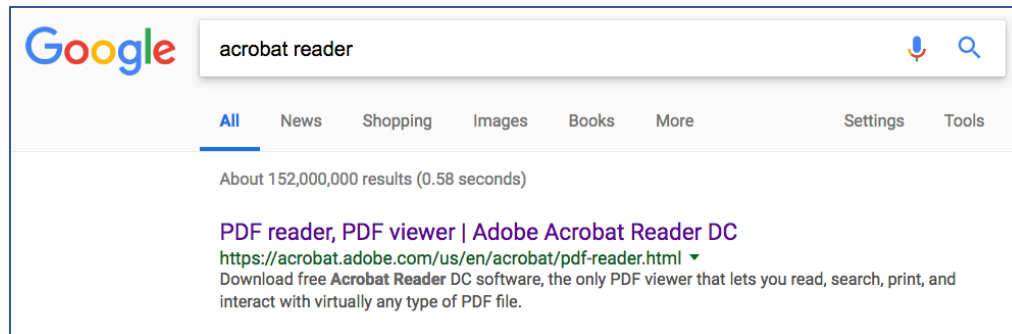


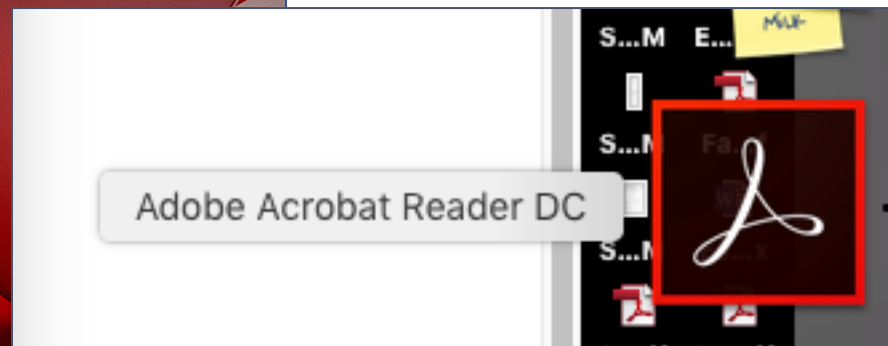
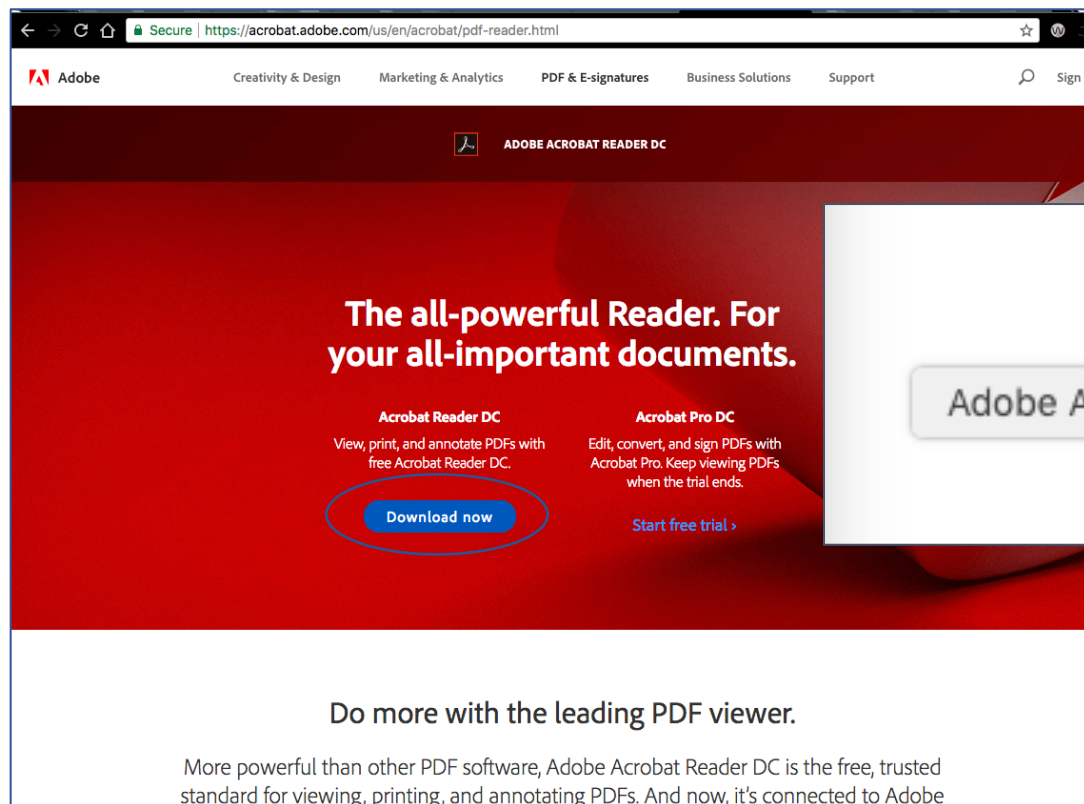
Adobe Acrobat Reader for Desktop Computer Annotation

3 Open a document after downloading it to your computer.
